EuroWEPS IX will be held as an in-person event <u>at the London School of Economics</u> <u>and Political Science, in London on Wednesday, 8 May 2024</u>. We provide accommodation, and travel funding of up to 200 Euros - provided by a generous grant from the LSE Government Department.

Applications with papers or detailed pre-analysis plans should be submitted by <u>3</u> April via email to <u>euroweps@gmail.com</u>. Women, minorities, and 1st generation academics are especially encouraged to apply. We will notify successful applicants by <u>10 April.</u> Researchers who present must be based in Europe. Non-presenters may also attend (without travel funding), but should register with us beforehand.
